- Healthcare costs in India are 10%–20% of costs in USA and Europe

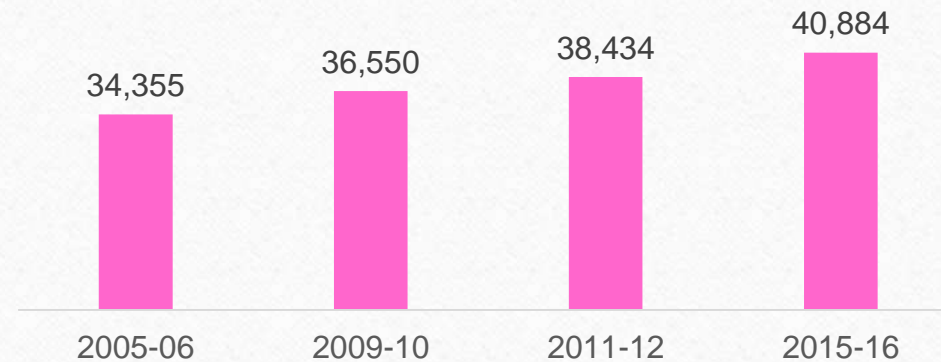


India is a leading destination for Healthcare services. Accelerating growth has been witnessed with increasing private sector participation.

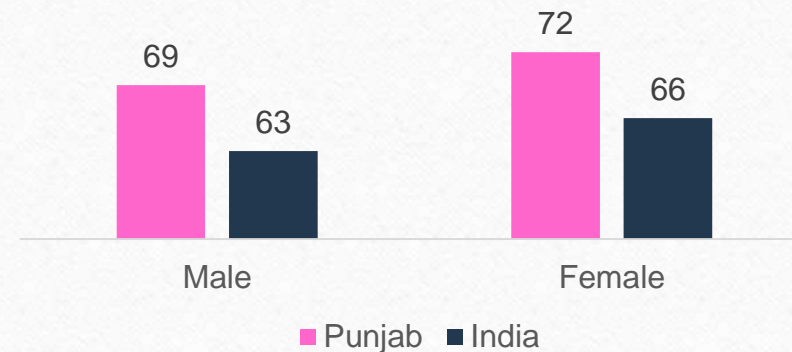
STATE PROFILE

Number of registered doctors



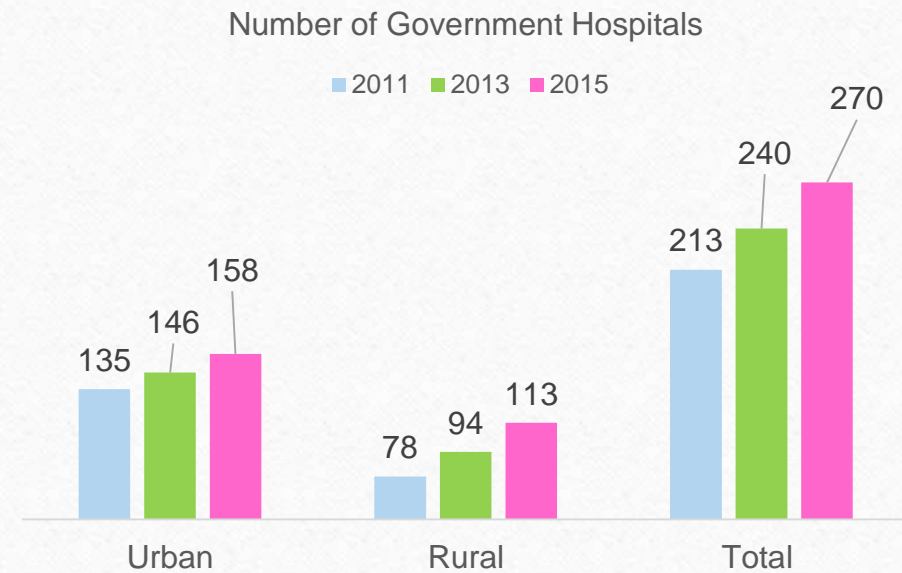
Life expectancy at birth

INITIATIVES

- The State has embarked upon a massive Skill Development plan to create infrastructure and start skill development courses in the three Government medical colleges (Amritsar, Faridkot, Patiala) which will be useful for the Healthcare industry
- These Health Sector Skill Development Centers offer generic courses (General Duty Assistant, Home Health Aide, Emergency Medical Technician- Basic) and specialty courses (Diet Assistant, Vision Technicians, Diabetes Educator etc.) with a total of 720 graduates annually
