Note: - The demarcation of mines has been done by the concerned Mining Officer with the assistance of district administration. The Khasra no., area & per annum extractable quantity shown in the table above are as per the environmental clearances obtained by the department.

Terms & Conditions for e-auction are as follows:-

- 1) The e-auction of mines will be through progressive bidding process.
- 2) Each bid shall be submitted online through e-procurement website www.etenderpunjabgovt.gov.in of Punjab Govt. website. Prospective bidder shall register himself on the e-procurement website to participate in the e-auction while taking in to consideration the following instructions –
To participate in the e-auction, prospective bidders shall have to get themselves registered with the e-Procurement portal (<http://etender.punjabgovt.gov.in>) and obtain user ID and password. Class 3 Digital Signature Certificate is mandatory for participating in the e-auction process.
 - a. The user ID shall be activated after submission of attested copies of:
 - b. identity proof
 - c. address proof
 - d. pan card
 - e. request letter for user ID activation on letterhead

All the documents must be attested by authorised signatory. The documents must be submitted by individual/proprietor, society, partnership firm, company, consortium etc. as applicable to the requesting entity. In the event of delay in submission of aforesaid documents or submission of incorrect documents the bidder shall be solely responsible for delay in user ID activation. All bidders are advised to register well in advance to avoid last-minute delays. For more details regarding registration process kindly refer to registration guidelines on the e- procurement website.

- 3) The person/firm/company having Certificate of Approval under rule 7 of Punjab Minor Mineral Rules, 2013, will be eligible for bidding in the e-auction.
- 4) Prospective bidder should participate in the e-auction while keeping in mind that he has not been black listed for participating in the e-auction by the department. Despite this, if he deposits EMD for participating in the e-auction, the EMD deposited will be forfeited and he will not be allowed to participate in the e-auction.
- 5) Prospective bidder shall upload his Certificate of Approval on the e-procurement website for participating in the e-auction. The certificate of approval should be in the name of prospective bidder and should be valid up to 31st December, 2017. In case, prospective bidder uploads the Certificate of Approval which is not in his name, then he will not be allowed to participate in the e-auction.
- 6) The prospective bidder shall deposit the Earnest money, processing fee through a designated bank account which should be in him name (or Company/firm). The detail of this designated bank account should be as per the performa given at Annexure-A of this notification and should be uploaded on the e-procurement website. In case, the detail is not uploaded as per Annexure-A or prospective bidder uploads the detail without bank attestation or without his signatures, then he will not be allowed to participate in the e-auction.
- 7) If prospective bidder deposits EMD, processing fee from the bank accounts other than his designated bank account, then he will not be allowed to participate in the e-auction. After completion of e-auction, the payment of 1st installment and security amount should be paid by the successful bidder only through this designated bank account and he will not be able to deposit any amount other than this bank account.
- 8) Prospective bidder shall upload the undertaking on the e-procurement web site for participating in the e-auction as per the Annexure-B1 (in case of individual) or Annexure-B2 (in case of firm/company) of this e-auction notification. In case the bidder do not upload undertaking as per the prescribed proforma or upload without his signatures or

gives incomplete information in Annexure-A, Annexure-B1 & Annexure-B2(does not fill all the blanks given in Annexures), then he will not be allowed to participate in the e-auction.

- 9) Prospective bidder shall deposit the earnest money on the e-procurement website through e-payment gateway as described in the column No. 8 of mines. In case the earnest money deposited is less, then he will not be allowed to participate in the e-auction.
- 10) Prospective bidders can upload/deposit his Certificate of Approval, earnest money and designated bank account detail from 14.06.2017 (10.00am) to 27.06.2017 (5.00pm).
- 11) Every bidder shall deposit 0.1% of reserve price as shown in column No. 7 of table of mines (which shall be minimum Rs. 500/- and maximum Rs. 5000/-) as processing fees along with service tax @15% of above processing fees through e-payment gateway. This amount shall not be refundable. In case the processing fee deposited is less, then he will not be allowed to participate in the e-auction.
- 12) The copy of e-auction notification can be collected from the office of respective Mining Officer, District Industries Centre or can be downloaded from the departmental website www.investpunjab.gov.in.
- 13) The prospective bidders at his own level and expenses can visit the mines included in the notification for his satisfaction whether he can operate the mine or not.
- 14) Successful bidder shall be bound to pay any other types of expenses fixed by the Government from time to time.
- 15) The bid for the mines shall start from their reserve price described at column No. 7 of the table of mines.
- 16) Reserve price of mines is Rs. 86 per tonne which includes royalty (Rs. 60 per tonne), 10% as Environment Management Fund (Rs. 6 per tonne) and 1/3 of royalty as District Mineral Foundation Fund (Rs. 20 per tonne). Bidder shall bid at reserve price or above that with incremental bid of Rs. 25000. The bidder cannot increase the bid more than Rs.10,00,000/- at a time.
- 17) Bidder shall bid on dates shown in the notification as per the time shown below.

- 18) If the bid is received in the last 5 minutes of the above shown date and time (i.e. between 10.55 am to 11.00 am or between 3.55 pm to 4.00 pm) then time for bidding will be automatically extended for 5 minutes, so that the bidders participating in bid can get equal chance. For bids from 9.00 am to 11.00 am, maximum extension of 5-5 minutes shall be upto 1.00 pm and for the bids from 2.00 pm to 4.00 pm, maximum extension of 5-5 minutes shall be upto 6.00 pm. The auction conditions will be same as shown in Punjab Minor Mineral Rules, 2013.
- 19) The H-1 bid received in the auction for the mine shall be its annual contract amount.
- 20) The training for participating and submission of bid shall be given to the prospective bidders. The scheduled date and time of this training shall be uploaded on the departmental website.
- 21) The contract period for the mines at serial No. 19, 20, 21, 22 and 54 shall be for 2 years and for the rest of the mines, the contract period shall be for 5 years from the date of issue of final acceptance or total extractable quantity or validity of environmental clearance, whichever is earlier.
- 22) In case the environmental clearance for the mine is expiring before the contract period, the contractor can, at his level and expenses, obtain environmental clearance for completing its contract period. The contractor shall be bound to transfer the extended environmental clearance in the name of new contractor.
- 23) The successful bidder shall execute and register the agreement as per Form-L under rule 40 of Punjab Minor Mineral Rules, 2013 within 30 days from the date of final acceptance is issued. In case the agreement is not executed/ registered within stipulated time, the final acceptance/contract shall be cancelled.
- 24) The provisional acceptance shall be issued by the Government in the name of successful bidder within 2 days. In the case of contracts where the annual amount of contract money is not more than Rs.10,00,000/- the entire balance amount for the first year shall be deposited by the contractor within two working days of issue of provisional acceptance of bid. In the case of contracts where the annual contract amount exceeds Rs. 10,00,000/- the Contractor shall deposit 25% as first installment within two days from the date of issue of provisional acceptance in the bank account of concerned Mining officer. If the successful bidder does not deposit the requisite amount within the stipulated time (within 2 days, upto 5.00 pm after issuance of provisional acceptance) then the earnest money deposited by him will be forfeited.

- 25) The successful bidder shall deposit security amount @ 25% of the annual contract amount along with quarterly compensation of land owner shown in column No. 9 of the table of mines as security in the axis bank account of concerned Mining Officer along with the contract amount installment. In case the successful bidders fails to deposit this amount (within 2 days, upto 5.00 pm after issuance of provisional acceptance) the Earnest money deposit shall be forfeit. The Mining officer shall deposit above stated contract amount and security in the district treasury.
- 26) The earnest money deposited by the successful bidders shall be adjusted in the 1st quarter installment.
- 27) The earnest money of the unsuccessful bidder shall be refunded within one week after provisional acceptance of contract is issued. This amount shall be refunded to the designated accounts through which the bidder remitted the earnest money.
- 28) The successful bidder after issuance of provisional acceptance, shall transfer the Environmental Clearance in his name and will take consent to operate from Punjab Pollution Control Board. Further, the successful bidder shall install weighbridge at the pit-head of mine and electronically generated weighment slip system before applying for final acceptance. The bidder shall apply for final acceptance within 30 days after issue of provisional acceptance. If bidder fails to apply for final acceptance within stipulated time without any valid reason, then their provisional acceptance shall be cancelled.
- 29) The contractor shall deposit Environment Performance Guarantee @ Rs.15,000/- per acre within 30 days from the date of issuance of final approval with the Mining Officer, in shape of FD/Cash/DD/Bank Guarantee having validity of 6 months over the contract period.
- 30) The contractor shall put up notice board at the pit head of every mine showing contact details of concerned Deputy Commissioner, Mining Officer, and contractor etc. so that any person can give complaint if any.
- 31) Successful bidder shall deposit the money paid by the Government for obtaining Environmental clearance, within 30 days from date of issuance of final acceptance, in the Government Treasury.
- 32) In case violation of conditions of auction notification or conditions of agreement or of acts and rules described at condition number 44 of notification, by the contractor, the contract shall be cancelled by the authorised officer.
- 33) During e-auction if any bidder violates any rules then he will not be allowed to participate in the e-auction and his Earnest Money Deposit shall be forfeited. If Director

decides that the violation is serious then he may prohibit the bidder to participate in e-auction for upto 3 years.

- 34) Any individual/company/firm etc. who have pending royalty or any other pending amount towards Government under Punjab Minor Mineral Rules, 2013 will not be eligible for participating in the e-auction.
- 35) To tackle any kind of violation during extraction, the clause of punishment, fine or both as prescribed in Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957 shall be applicable on the contract.
- 36) In public interest, the Director reserves the rights to cancel the bid given by the bidder and to exclude any mine from the auction Notification without giving any reason.
- 37) The contractor shall deposit the quarterly compensation in the bank account of Central Government/State Government/Panchayat/Private land owners @ Rs.60/- per tonne through cheque as per the extraction done. The same shall be informed to Mining Officer while producing the evidence. In case of violation, the contract shall be cancelled as per rules and contractor shall be blacklisted for 5 years. This amount shall be other than contract amount.
- 38) The contractor shall install weighment machine at the pit-head of the mine for measurement of minor mineral in that very condition in which it has been excavated and shall be measured and whatever mineral is excavated during whole day, shall be sold or had prepared any product during last 24 hours shall entered in the Accounts Register. The contractor shall allow the government employee near the weight machine so that he may check the register of measuring weight etc by the contractor.
- 39) The contractor shall send details of each measured vehicle electronically to concerned mining officer in prescribed form-T and the mining officer after verification of the said details issue electronically slip in prescribed form-T, which shall be downloaded by contractor and shall use for transit loaded minor mineral.
- 40) For smooth operation of mining activity, if the Government implements modern technology (software based system) in future, then contractors shall be bound to pay upto Rs.5/- per tonne and shall provide shelter, lodging etc. for the person/security deputed at the pit head for maintenance and operation of such system.
- 41) The time for excavation during summer (1st April to 30th September) shall be from morning 6 O'clock to evening 7 O'clock and in winter (1st October to 31st March) shall be from morning 7 O'clock to evening 5 O'clock.

- 42) The contractor shall arrange for drinking water, rest shelters, latrines, first aid and medical facilities for workers to the satisfaction of competent authority under Mines Act, 1952, Inter-State Migrate Workmen Act, Central-State Government Labour Laws.
- 43) In the event of violation of these rules or Acts, the contract can be cancelled by giving sufficient opportunity or without giving notice in case of any emergency by competent authority and the amount deposited by the contractor at the time of auction on account of security can be used for the above said purpose.
- 44) The Contractor before approval shall obtain consent to operate from the Punjab Pollution Control Board and shall comply with the provisions of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, Punjab Land Security Act, 1900, Indian Forest Act, 1927, Wild Lives (Preservation) Act, 1972, Mines Act, 1952, Mines and Minerals (Regulation and Development) Act, 1957, Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and Punjab Minor Mineral Rules, 2013 framed there under.
- 45) The conditions mentioned in environment clearance shall be binding on the successful bidder and the excavation in mines shall be carried out under these conditions.
- 46) The contractor shall bound to deposit T.D.S under Section 206-C(IC) of the Finance Act, 2004. Every contractor shall bound to supply the Pan Number (for Income Tax) and TIN Number (for VAT) to the concerned Mining Officer.
- 47) There shall be ban on excavation of any manner as per rules 41(8)(9)(10)(11) & (12) of Punjab Minor Mineral Rules, 2013 at rivers, canals, flood control barrage, roads, railway lines, bridges, structures and for safety of the area adjoining thereof.
- 48)
 - (a) There shall be no excavation unless the benches are prepared as per Regulation 106 of Metalliferous Mines Regulation, 1961 and in plain areas the mining of mineral can be carried out upto 3 feet deep and shall be measured from un-mined ground level.
 - (b) There shall be ban on excavation of any kind upto 100 meters from inside the main rivers of the State such as Satluj, Ravi, Beas, Ghaghar and Chakki etc. and barrage for controlling flood. Similarly there shall be ban on excavation upto 500 meters from outside the above said barrages.
 - (c) The excavation from remaining rivers shall be as per conditions of environment clearance.

- (d) There shall be ban on any kind of excavation upto 500 meters from the high level bridge towards upstream and downstream. Similarly for other bridges, there shall be ban on any kind of excavation upto 250 meters.
 - (e) There shall be ban on excavation inside upto 75 meters from railway line (except with permission from Railway Administration) and inside upto 60 meters from National Highway or other bridges.
 - (f) Similarly there shall be ban on any kind of excavation upto 50 meters inside from rivers, reservoirs, tank or other public works such as public road and building or residential places (except with prior written consent from government or competent officer).

 - (h) There shall be ban on any kind of excavation upto 7.5 meter circle inside from of any government or private place.
 - (i) The excavation in rivers can be carried out maximum upto 3 meters deep or water table, whichever is less.
- 49) It shall be the responsibility of the contractor to carry out excavation of minor mineral as per conditions of Environment Management Plan. In this regard District Mineral Foundation alongwith Mining Officer and District Nodal Officer (ADC) shall keep check.
- 50) It shall be the responsibility of the contractor to level the pits, ditches simultaneously after carrying out excavation work so that there may not be any untoward incident and after mining is restored.
- 51) In the event of violation of any conditions mentioned in the agreement, conditions mentioned in Environment Management Plan and the conditions mentioned in auction Notification etc, his contract can be cancelled under Punjab Minor Mineral Rules, 2013.
- 52) There shall be no permission to carry out excavation work below water table.
- 53) The Contractor shall not carry out any excavation work of minor mineral at Protected Reservoir or any forest-area (un-notified).
- 54) In case any amendment is made in the Punjab Minor Mineral Rules, 2013, Government Rules and Instructions during contract period the same shall be binding on the contractor.
- 55) Contractor shall not carry out excavation of minor mineral beyond maximum limit per year as mentioned in column No.6 of the notification of auction.
- 56) There shall be increase of 10% every year in the contract amount.

- 57) The issue of this Tender Document does not imply that the State Government is bound to select a Bidder as Successful Bidder for the sand block specified hereinafter and the State Government reserves the right to reject all or any of the Bidders or bids without assigning any reason whatsoever.
- 58) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Bid Document, the State Government reserves the right to reject any bid and/or to annul the Bidding process and reject all bids at any time without any liability or any obligation for such acceptance, rejection or annulment, and without assigning any reasons thereof.
- 59) The Bidders and their respective officials/representatives shall observe the highest standard of ethics during the Bidding process and subsequent to the grant of the mining contract. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained herein, the State Government may reject a bid, withdraw the mining contract, as the case may be, without being liable in any manner whatsoever to the Bidder or to the Successful Bidder, as the case may be. If the State Government determine that the Bidder or the Successful Bidder, as the case may be, has, directly or indirectly or through an agent, engaged in any corrupt fraudulent practice, coercive practice, undesirable practice or restrictive practice in the bidding process or subsequent to allotment, in such an event, the State Government shall be entitled to forfeit and appropriate the Earnest Money or Performance Security, as the case may be, as damages, without prejudice to any other right or remedy that may be available to the State Government under the Tender Document and/ or otherwise. However before taking such an action, opportunity to show cause shall be issued to the affected parties in order to comply with the principles of natural justice.
